- Oversee and Perform Ground Operations such as but not limited to; Aircraft Marshalling, Ground Support Equipment Operation, Load Stage and Load Builds, Cargo and Baggage Handling, Loading and Off-loading of Aircraft, Cargo Receiving, Inventory Management, Refueling of Aircraft, De-Ice of Aircraft, Ramp and Hangar cleanliness and organization
- Assignment of duties to Teams for Receiving, Staging, Aircraft Loading, and General Duties
- Coaching and assisting your teams in their duties and as directed by your Base Manager, performing On-The-Job Training with employees
- Monitoring and ensuring that the highest level of care if given to freight especially within the categories of; Fragile, Cooler, Frozen, Do Not Freeze, DG, Rush and any other category you find requires special handling
